Pursuant to notice, the Murray County Board of Commissioners convened with the following members present: Commissioners James Jens, Robert Moline, Gerald Magnus, David Thiner and Glenn Kluis. Also present Aurora Heard, County Coordinator, Heidi Winter, Auditor-Treasurer. Excused Absence: Travis Smith, County Attorney. Several county employees and members of the public were present.

The meeting opened by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

On Monday November 9th, the Murray County Commissioners intended on having a special meeting to hear the findings of an organization report which was to be presented by Gary Weirs of David Drown Associates.
